Girls Uniform

All hair should be neatly tied back completely off the face with no fringes or loose pieces of hair. Purple ribbon can be worn in the hair to match the uniform. No Jewellery to be worn (including earrings.) Correct shoes are vital to ensure that the children and students are learning the dances from the different countries correctly.

Once your child has settled into classes with us, we recommend that they wear the following:

- Purple lycra long sleeved leotard and pink ballet tights with feet in



- Black canvas character shoes with elastic for hard shoe countries



- Pink ballet shoes with elastic for soft shoe countries



- Black National full circular skirt, made to fit each child individually, with a petersham waist band and zip. Each skirt has three full circles of purple ribbon on the bottom to match the leotard and these will be our school colours. These are priced at £32 and are only available to buy from the school as they are made by Chris Wright. Please bring money in an envelope to class in order for your skirt to be made.



For all ISTD Tap and Modern Theatre exams, this regulation uniform is compulsory.

Chris Wright's school t-shirt, sweat shirt or hooded sweatshirt may also be worn until warm over the leotard.
